Beth yw Cynllunio Lle?

Mae Medrwn Môn wedi bod yn gweithio mewn partneriaeth â Chyngor Sir Ynys Môn ar y rhaglen Cynllunio Lle ar gyfer yr Ynys ers 2019. Mae Cynllunio Lle yn ddull mapio seiliedig ar asedau i nodi'r blaenoriaethau o fewn pob ward ac unrhyw flaenoriaethau cyffredin ar draws yr Ynys.



Mae blaenoriaethau yn cael eu nodi a'u gweithio gan gynghrair gymunedol sy'n cynnwys trigolion cymunedol, grwpiau cymunedol lleol a sefydliadau 3ydd sector, cynghorau cymuned, cynghorwyr sir, a busnesau lleol. Mae pob cynghrair yn cael swm bach o gyllid sbarduno i greu prosiectau tasgau a gorffen h.y. cynlluniau trafnidiaeth gymunedol bach, gweithgareddau lleol neu adnewyddu ac adnewyddu canolfannau cymunedol ar raddfa fach

What is Place Shaping?

Medrwn Môn has been working in partnership with Anglesey County Council on the place shaping programme for the Island since 2019. Place Shaping is an asset-based mapping approach to identifying the priorities within each ward and any common priorities across the Island.

Priorities are identified and worked on by a community alliance which is made up of community residents, local community groups & 3rd sector organisations, community councils, County Councillors, and local businesses. Each alliance is given a small amount of seed funding to create task and finish projects i.e. small community transport schemes, local activities or small scale refurbishment and renovation of community hubs.

At present there are alliances established in Seiriol, Aethwy, Bodowyr, Crigyll, Bro Aberffraw, Bro'r Llynnoedd, Caergybi, and Lligwy wards.

This booklet showcases the excellent work that these alliances have completed across the Island!

Yn dilyn pryderon ynglŷn â thraffig yn ardal Gwalchmai, wnaeth aelodau o cynghrair Crigyll penderfynu gwirfoddoli i fod yn rhan o gynllun 'speedwatch' sy'n fenter genedlaethol lle mae aelodau cymunedau, mewn partneriaeth â'r heddlu, yn defnyddio dyfeisiau datgelu i fonitro cyflymder cerbydau lleol.



Fe wnaethant ymgynghori â chynghrair Bro'r Llynnoedd, a chael profiad o fod yn rhan o'r rhaglen gwyllo cyflymder a chwblhau'r hyfforddiant drwy Heddlu Gogledd Cymru. Diolch i Bro'r Llynnoedd am gael menthyg yr offer. Bydd y gwirfoddolwyr yn monitro traffig yn yr ardal unwaith y bydd yr asesiadau wedi'u cwblhau.

"Mae'r prosiect Speedwatch yn adlewyrchu ein hymroddiad ar y cyd i adeiladu cymuned fwy diogel i bawb. Due to the traffic concerns in the Gwalchmai area, members of the Crigyll alliance decided to be part of the 'speedwatch' programme, which is a national initiative, where, in partnership with the police, members of communities use detection devices to monitor local vehicle speeds.

They consulted with the Bro'r Llynnoedd alliance, having experience of being part of the speedwatch programme and completed the training through North Wales Police. Thank you to Bro'r Llynnoedd for the loan of the equipment. The volunteers will monitor traffic in the area once the assessments have been completed.

As an alliance, we have made it our priority to combat speeding, recognising its direct impact on the safety and well-being of our roads. By actively monitoring speeds and raising awareness, we aim to foster a sense of shared responsibility, ensuring that every driver and pedestrian can move freely and securely. This initiative is not just about reducing speed—it's about protecting lives, strengthening community trust, and making road safety a priority for everyone."

Bro Aberffraw a Crigyll

Mae Cynghrair Bro Aberffraw a Crigyll wedi cydweithio i sicrhau cyllid o £20,000 gan raglen Arian i Bawb y Loteri Genedlaethol Cymru. Cysylltodd Sarah Rawsthorn o Edge Inclusion (aelod o Crigyll) â Sara Spinks (Cadeirydd Bro Aberffraw) drwy Ddigwyddiad Arddangos y Gynghrair, gan ddod â'u profiad a'u cefndir proffesiynol at ei gilydd i greu prosiect ar gyfer pobl ifanc yn y ddwy Ward. Bydd y prosiect yn mynd i'r afael ag un o'r blaenoriaethau wedi'i nodi gan y ddwy Gynghrair, sef Plant a Phobl Ifanc. Bydd y prosiect lles iechyd meddwl o fudd i blant a phobl ifanc Wardiau Crigyll a Bro Aberffraw drwy gynnig sesiynau am ddim sy'n dysgu pobl ifanc i ddysgu am strategaethau hunanreoleiddio emosiynol.

Bro Aberffraw and Crigyll

Bro Aberffraw and Crigyll alliance have worked together to secure funding of £20,000 from the National Lottery Awards For All programme. Sarah Rawsthorn from Edge Inclusion (Crigyll member) and Sara Spinks (Chairperson of Bro Aberffraw) connected through the Alliance Showcase Event, bringing their experience and professional back grounds together to create a project for young people in both Wards. The project will address one of the priorities identified by both Alliances, that of Children and Young People.

The mental Health wellbeing project will benefit the children and young people of the Crigyll and Bro Aberffraw Wards by offering free sessions that teach young people to learn about emotional self-regulation strategies.

Gweithio Mewn Partneriaeth

Bydd y Cyngreiriau yn cael eu gwahodd i weithio gydag Ymddiriedolaeth Adeiladu Cymunedau trwy gyfle cyffrous i ymgysylltu a cheisio dylanwadu ar fanifesto'r blaid ar gyfer yr etholiadau nesaf yn 2026. Bydd y sesiynau'n dechrau ym mis Mehefin 2025.

Yn ogystal â'r Platfform Map Cyhoeddus hwn, mae Free Ice Cream a Medrwn Môn yn gweithio gyda grwpiau a sefydliadau cymunedol i fasio'r holl ffyrdd y maent yn gweithio gyda'i gilydd o amgylch nodau a rennir. Bydd y map ei hun yn dangos i ni ble mae'r rhwydweithiau cefnogi, lle mae unrhyw fylchau a bydd yn ein helpu i weithio'n well gyda'n gilydd i greu Ynys Môn fwy gwydn! **Enghreifftiau gwych o gynghreiriau yn dod at ei gilydd i rannu adnoddau a chefnogi cymunedau.**

Working in Partnership

The Alliances will be invited to work with Building Communities Trust through an exciting opportunity to engage and try to influence the party manifestos for the next elections in 2026 . Sessions will begin in June 2025.

In addition to this Public Map Platform, Free Ice Cream and Medrwn Môn are working with community groups and organisations to map all the ways in which they work together around shared goals. The map itself will show us where the networks of support are, where there are any gaps and will help us to work better together to create a more resilient Anglesey!

Gweithio gyda phlant a phobl ifanc



1. Ysgol Gynradd y Fali

Roedd Ysgol Gymuned y Fali yn gweithio ar Brosiect Gwella Ardaloedd Lleol ac roedd eu gwaith yn cyd-fynd â nodau is-grŵp Plant a Phobl Ifanc. Cysylltodd aelod o'r Gynghrair a Chyngħorydd Cymuned leol â Phennaeth yr Ysgol a oedd yn gefnogol ac yn frwdfrydig wrth dymuno gweithio gyda'i gilydd.


Gyda'i gilydd fe wnaethant drafod 2 fater i weithio arnynt.

MATER 1: Dywedodd y bobl ifanc wrth y Cyngor Cymuned am yr angen am fyrrdau picnic yn y parc chwarae ger yr ysgol. Dywedodd eu harolwg wrthym fod bron i 100% ohonynt yn defnyddio'r parc chwarae ar ryw adeg ond nad oedd unman i rieni a theuluoedd eistedd.



GWEITHRED: Mae'r Cyngor Cymuned bellach wedi prynu a gosod dwy fainc bicnic.

MATER 2: Amlygodd yr arolwg bryder diogelwch am geir yn parcio y tu allan i Swyddfa Bost y Fali lle mae llinellau melyn dwbl.



GWEITHRED: Trosglwyddwyd hyn i'r Cyngor Sir; Mr Alun Roberts Uwch Beiriannydd Traffig a Pharcio. Cydnabu eu pryderon a dywedodd fod 'cynnig croesfan i gerddwyr ar Ffordd yr Orsaf yn flaenoriaeth a gwneir pob ymdrech i sicrhau cyllid ar gyfer ei gosod'. Er nad oes sicrwydd y bydd y Fali yn cael croesfan i gerddwyr, mae barn y bobl ifanc wedi'i chlywed.

2. Beth all pobl ifanc ei gynnig?



Gan fod y Gynghrair wedi dewis pobl ifanc fel un o'i blaenoriaethau, roedd y grŵp yn awyddus i ddeall sut y gallai pobl ifanc eu helpu i gyflawni'r blaenoriaethau hynny ac o bosibl awgrymu prosiect a gweithgareddau a fyddai'n eu helpu i gyflawni eu nodau. I wneud hyn, treuliodd y Gynghrair ac aelodau o staff Medrwn Môn y diwrnod yn Ysgol Uwchradd Bodedern yn siarad â phobl ifanc am y sgiliau a'r profiadau a oedd ganddynt a fyddai'n helpu i ennyn eu diddordeb yn ngwaith y Cynghrair. Ymunodd dros 200 o bobl ifanc ar y diwrnod a mynegi eu bod yn fodlon rhannu eu sgiliau wrth helpu i ddylunio prosiectau, ymgysylltu â phobl ifanc eraill a rhannu gwybodaeth mewn fformatau newydd. Bydd hwn yn cael ei ddefnyddio wrth ddatblygu prosiect fel yr un isod.

3. Prosiect Parc Mwd

Mae hwn yn brosiect ar y cyd rhwng y Gynghrair a Chyngor Cymuned y Fali. Mae'r prosiect yn gweithio gyda phobl ifanc i ddylunio a chyflwyno prosiect sy'n cynnig mwy o gyfleusterau i bobl ifanc ym Mharc Mwd.



Mae'r grŵp wedi ymgynghori'n helaeth â phobl ifanc, trigolion a grwpiau â diddordeb ac ar hyn o bryd yn chwilio am gyllid ar gyfer y prosiect. Dyma enghraifft dda arall o gydweithio gyda Chyngħorau Cymuned i allu datblygu asedau a chynnig rhywbeth newydd i'w cymunedau.

Bro'r Llynnoedd

Working with children and young people



1. Valley Primary School

Valley School were working on a Local Area Improvement Project and their work matched the aims of the Children & Young People's subgroup. A member of the Alliance and a local Community Councillor approached the Head of the School who was supportive and enthusiastic in wanting to work together.

Together they discussed 2 issues to work on.


ISSUE 1: The young people told the Community Council about the need for picnic tables in the play park by the school. Their survey told us that almost 100% of them used the play park at some time but there was nowhere for parents and families to sit

ACTION: The Community Council has now purchased and installed two picnic benches.



ISSUE 2: The survey highlighted a safety concern about cars parking outside the Valley Post Office where there are double yellow lines.

ACTION: This was relayed to the County Council; Mr Alun Roberts Senior Engineer Traffic & Parking. He acknowledged their concerns and stated 'the proposal of a pedestrian crossing on Station Road is a priority and every effort will be made to ensure funding for its installation'. Although there is no guarantee that Valley will get a pedestrian crossing, the views of the young people have been heard.



2. What can young people offer?



As the Alliance had chosen young people as one of its priorities, the group were keen to understand how young people could help them to achieve those priorities and possibly suggest project and activities that would help them achieve their aims. To do this the Alliance and members of Medrwn Môn staff spent the day in Bodden High School talking with young people about the skills and experiences they had that would help to engage them

in the work of the Alliance. Over 200 young people joined on the day and expressed that they were willing to share their skills in helping to design projects, to engage other young people and to share information in new formats. This will be used in the development of project like the one below.

3. Parc Mwd project

This is a joint project between the Alliance and Valley Community Council. The project is working with young people to design and deliver a project that offers young people more facilities at Parc Mwd.

The group have done extensive consultation with young people, residents and interested groups and are currently looking for funding for the project. This is another good example of joint working with Community Councils to be able to develop assets and offer something new to their communities.



Bro'r Llynnoedd

Prosiect Pel-fasged Parc Mwd

Mae hwn yn brosiect ar y cyd rhwng y Gynghrair a Chyngor Cymuned y Fali. Mae'r prosiect yn gweithio gyda phobl ifanc i ddylunio a chyflwyno prosiect sy'n cynnig mwy o gyfleusterau i bobl ifanc ym Mharc Mwd. Mae'r grŵp wedi cynnal ymgynghoriad helaeth gyda phobl ifanc a thrigolion yr ardal. Roedd 100% o'r bobl a holwyd yn cytuno bod angen datblygu Parc Mwd a theimlai 84% mai cae pêl fasged fyddai'r opsiwn mwyaf addas i'w ddatblygu. Roedd adborth yn cynnwys:

'Mae mynediad i weithgareddau awyr agored rhad ac am ddim yn hanfodol ac mae cael man lle gall teuluoedd a ffrindiau gyfarfod yn hanfodol ar gyfer llesiant . Mae hefyd yn wych ar gyfer gweithgareddau aml-genhedlaeth a all hefyd fod yn dda i les a pherthynas deuluol chwarae gyda'i gilydd'.

Bydd y prosiect yn costio tua £40,000. Mae'r Gynghrair wedi ymrwymo £3,000 o'i chyllid cychwynnol ac mae'r grŵp wedi sicrhau £20,000 gan y Grant Arian i Bawb y Loteri, £5,000 gan Gronfa Gymunedol Dŵr Cymru a £10,000 gan Ymddiriedolaeth Elusennol Ynys Môn. Unwaith y bydd y grŵp wedi sicrhau'r swm terfynol o gyllid sydd ei angen, dylai'r prosiect ddod i ben erbyn diwedd mis Tachwedd eleni!



Prosiect Campfa Heulwen Parc Mwd



Yr ail brosiect mae'r Cyngair a Chyngor Cymuned y Fali yn gweithio arno yw'r Sunshine Gym ym Mharc Mwd. Gyda'i gilydd fe wnaethon nhw sicrhau £7,500 o gronfa Mannau Gwyrdd Medrwn Môn trwy gronfa Bro Ffyniant Llywodraeth y DU.



Daw'r prosiect o dan flaenoriaethau'r Gynghrair sef pobl ifanc a mannau cymunedol. Mae diffyg cyfleusterau ar gyfer pobl ifanc yn eu harddegau a phobl hŷn ac nid oes neuadd bentref na man cyfarfod canolog yn y gymuned. Y cyfleusterau campfa awyr agored sydd am ddim i'w defnyddio bob amser.

Dyweddodd preswylwyr y byddai '**'campfa awyr agored hefyd o fudd i'r genhedlaeth hŷn yn ogystal â'r genhedlaeth iau sydd ddim yn gallu mynd i gampfa dan do'**'.



Bydd y prosiect yn cynnwys gwirfoddolwyr 'Cyfeillion Parc Mwd' yn gweithio i ailosod ffensys a thorri llwyni sydd wedi gordyfu ac adnewyddu'r ffiniau o amgylch y triongl a darparu ardal debyg i 'Gampfa Werdd' lle gall pobl gymdeithasu wrth ddatblygu eu sgiliau garddio. Bydd cynrychiolwyr o'r gymuned yn cael eu cyfethol i Bwyllgor Parciau'r Cyngor i helpu i gynllunio, cyflawni a monitro'r prosiect.

Parc Mwd basketball pitch project



This is a joint project between the Alliance and Valley Community Council. The project is working with young people to design and deliver a project that offers young people more facilities at Parc Mwd. The group have done extensive consultation with young people and residents of the area. 100% of the people surveyed agreed that Parc Mwd needed developing and 84% felt that a basket ball pitch would be the most suitable option for development. Feedback included :

'Access to free outdoor activities is vital and having a space where families and friends can meet is essential for wellbeing . It is also great for multi-generational activities which can also be good for wellbeing and family relationship to play together'.

The project will cost in the region of £40,000. The Alliance has committed £3,000 of it's seed funding and the group has secured £20,000 from the Lottery Awards for All grant, £5,000 from Welsh Water Community Fund and £10,000 from the Anglesey Charitable Trust. Once the group has secured the final amount of funding needed, the project should be finished by the end of November this year!



Parc Mwd Sunshine Gym project



A second project the Alliance and Valley Community Council are working on is the Sunshine Gym in Parc Mwd. Together they secured £7,500 from Medrwn Môn's Green Spaces fund through the UK Government Shared Prosperity fund.



The project comes under the Alliance priorities of young people and community spaces. There is a lack of facilities for teenagers and older people and that there is no village hall or central meeting place in the community. The outdoor gym facilities that is free to be used at all times. Residents stated that an '**outdoor gym would also benefit older generation as well as younger that are not able to go to an indoor gym**'.



The project will involve 'Friends of Parc Mwd' volunteers working to replace fencing and cutting back overgrown shrubs and refreshing the borders surrounding the triangle and providing a 'Green Gym' type area where people can socialise whilst developing their gardening skills. Representatives from the community will be co-opted to the Council's Parks Committee to help plan, deliver and monitor the project.

Mae'r Gynghrair wedi rhyddhau dwy rownd o gyllid sbarduno ac wedi ariannu 8 prosiect cymunedol sy'n eu helpu i gyflawni eu blaenoriaethau. Isod ceir drosolwg o rai o'r prosiectau a ariannwyd!



Clwb Pêl-droed Iau Bodedern

Dyfarnwyd £1250 i gynnal gwersyll pêl-droed diwrnod llawn yn ystod gwyliau'r haf ac i gefnogi costau ymuno â'r clwb ar gyfer plant y mae'n bosibl nad oes gan eu teuluoedd yr arian i dalu am subs, ffioedd a chitiau. Cymerodd dros 50 o blant o'r clwb a'r gymuned ehangach ran. Agorwyd sesiynau hefyd i blant gyda phroblemau symudedd ac mae'r clwb wedi ennill 17 aelod newydd o ganlyniad!



Ysgol Gymuned Y Fali-prosiect coginio

Dyfarnwyd £500 tuag at eu cegin gymunedol a'u sesiynau coginio. Darparodd y Gynghrair arian tuag at offer, cynhwysion coginio a pherlysiau a sbeisys y gallai'r plant eu tyfu ar dir yr ysgol. Mae peth o'r bwyd yn cael ei fwyta yn yr ysgol ac mae peth o'r cynnyrch, fel siytni, yn cael ei werthu ar facebook ac mewn ffeiriau ysgol! Mae hyn yn ffordd wych o ddatblygu sgiliau'r plant yn ogystal â chreu awyrgylch hwyliog ar gyfer gweithio fel tîm!



Neuadd Bentref Caergeiliog

Dyfarnwyd £1,400 i'w roi tuag at arian cyfatebol arall i wneud nifer o welliannau i'r Neuadd Bentref i'w gwneud yn fwy hygrych a chroesawgar i deuluoedd ifanc, trigolion oedrannus a defnyddwyr anabl. Y Neuadd Bentref yw'r unig adeilad cymunedol sydd ar gael i drigolion Caergeiliog a Llanfihangel yn Nhowyn.

Eglwys St Edern, Eglwys Lego Bodedern



Dyfarnwyd £700 o dan y blaenoriaethau pobl ifanc a manau cymunedol. Cynhaliodd y grŵp sesiynau teulu yn gwahodd pobl i gysylltu trwy adeiladu â lego. Roedd prydau hefyd ar gael yn y sesiynau yn ogystal â chyfnewid gwisg ysgol, cyfnewid tegannau ac ati. Cynhalwyd 4 sesiwn, gyda 3 cenhedlaeth o un teulu yn mynchyu un sesiwn! Bellach mae gan y grŵp yr offer i barhau i gynnal y sesiynau ac maent wedi cynllunio mwy ar gyfer y dyfodol.

Cysylltwch â Digwyddiadau Nadolig yr Henoed - RAF Fali



Mae Cyswllt â'r Henoed yn gynulliad prynhawn misol yn Hyb Cymunedol RAF Fali. Dyfarnwyd £250 i'r grŵp i gynnal sesiynau dros fisioedd y gaeaf. Mae'r prosiect yn diwallu anghenion y rhai mwyaf agored i niwed yn ein cymunedau sy'n cael eu heffeithio gan yr argyfwng costau byw. Mae dros 20 o bobl yn mynchyu'r sesiynau bob tro ac yn cael eu rhedeg gan wirfoddolwyr.

Funding projects against priorities

The Alliance has released two rounds of seed funding and funded 8 community projects that help them to achieve their priorities. Below is an overview of some of the funded projects;



Bodedern Junior Football Club

were awarded £1250 to hold a full day's football camp during the summer holidays and to support the costs of joining the club for children who's families may not have the money to pay for subs, fees and kits. Over 50 children from the club and wider community took part. Sessions were also opened to children with mobility problems and the club has gained 17 new members as a result!



Ysgol Gymuned Y Fali-Cookery Project

were awarded £500 towards their community kitchen and cookery sessions. The Alliance provided funding towards equipment, cooking ingredients and herbs and spices that could be grown by the children on school grounds. Some of the food is eaten in school and some of the produce, such as chutneys, is sold on facebook and in school fayres! This is a great way of developing the children's skills as well as creating a fun environment for working as a team!



Caergeiliog Village Hall

were awarded £1,400 to put towards other match funding to make a number of improvements to the Village Hall to make it more accessible and welcoming to young families, elderly residents and disabled users. The Village Hall is the only community building available to the residents of Caergeiliog and Llanfihangel yn Nhowyn.

Eglwys St Edern, Bodedern Lego Church



were awarded £700 under the young people and community spaces priorities. The group ran family sessions inviting people to connect through building with lego. Meals were also available at the sessions as well as uniform swaps, toy swaps etc. 4 sessions were held, with 3 generations of one family attending one session! The group now has the equipment to keep holding the sessions and have planned more for the future.

Contact the Elderly Christmas Events- RAF Valley



Contact the Elderly is a monthly afternoon gathering at the RAF Valley Community Hub. The group were awarded £250 to hold sessions over the winter months. The project meets the needs of the most vulnerable in our communities who are affected by the cost-of-living crisis. The sessions have over 20 people attending each time and are run by volunteers.

Clwb Pêl-droed Iau Bodedern- £500



Cymerodd dros 50 o blant o'r clwb a'r gymuned ehangach ran. Mae'r prosiect wedi helpu plant o bob oed i wneud cysylltiadau i gwrdd â ffrindiau newydd drwy'r sesiynau.

Roedd y prosiect yn ymgysylltu â'r gymuned ehangach fel bod y Clwb yn gallu agor sesiynau i'r gymuned leol nid yn unig i blant chwaraewyr y clwb sy'n oedolion. Croesawodd y Clwb chwaraewyr newydd nad oedd wedi chwarae pêl-droed o'r blaen, yn ogystal â'r rhai a brofodd rwystrau i ymuno o'r blaen oherwydd anableddau.



Un plentyn a gofrestrwyd ar ôl y gwersyll pêl-droed oedd George, roedd o'n cael trafferth a phoenau yn ei gymalau a'i glun oherwydd gor-symudedd. Mynychodd George y diwrnod hwyl pêl-droed, er nad oedd o wedi chwarae pêl-droed o'r blaen oherwydd ei gyflwr a ddim tîm lleol arall ar gael i gefnogi ei anghenion, ac ar ôl sawl ymgais, llwyddodd George i chwarae o'r diwedd!!

Mae'r prosiect wedi helpu plant i fod yn gorfforol egniol, mae wedi rhoi rhywbeth gwerthfawr i blant y clwb a'r gymuned yn eu taith bêl-droed. Daeth y diwrnod hwyl pêl-droed â 17 o chwaraewyr newydd i mewn!

Ysgol Gymuned Y Fali- Prosiect Coginio- £500

Yn nhymor y gwanwyn aeth y plant ati i glirio a chwynnu gardd yr ysgol fel y gallant blannu gwahanol berlysiau, llysiau a llwyni ffrwythau. Fe wnaethon nhw hefyd brynu'r offer angenrheidiol ar gyfer gwneud bwyd.

Roedd gwersi garddio a choginio pwrrpasol yn allweddol i lwyddiant a datblygiad llawer o'r plant, gan gynnwys disgyblion ag anghenion dysgu ychwanegol.

Roedd rhieni a gwirfoddolwyr o'r gymuned leol wedi helpu yng ngardd yr ysgol, gan sicrhau bod eu harbenigedd a'u gwybodaeth yn cael ei drosglwyddo i'r plant.

Gan weithio i themâu dosbarth yr ysgol ar gyfer pob tymor, roeddym yn gallu cynnig llawer o gyfleoedd i'r plant bobî, coginio a gwneud gwahanol brydau. Bu plant Blynnyddoedd 5 a 6 yn cynllunio, paratoi a choginio cinio rhost i'w hunain fel rhan o'u gwaith ar y Titanic. Bu blwyddyn 3 a 4 yn paratoi te Cymreig traddodiadol i gwblhau eu prosiect gydag ysgolion creadigol.

Mae'r plant wedi dysgu sgiliau bywyd gwerthfawr. Mae Ysgol Gymuned y Fali hefyd wedi bod yn llwyddiannus mewn cystadlaethau coginio dros y flwyddyn ddiwethaf, dod yn gyntaf ac yn ail drwy Ynys Môn yn y Gystadleuaeth CogUrdd.

Funding projects against priorities

The Alliance has released two rounds of seed funding and funded community projects that help them to achieve their priorities. Below is an overview of some of the funded projects;



Bodedern Junior Football Club- £500



Over 50 children from the club and wider community took part. The project has helped children of all ages make connections meet new friends through the sessions.

The project engaged with the wider community so that the Club were able to open up sessions to the local community not just children of the club adult players. The Club welcomed new players who had never played football before, as well as those who experienced barriers to joining previously due to disabilities.

One child who was enrolled after the football camp was George, he struggled a lot with joint and hip pain due to hyper mobility. George attended the football fun day without ever playing football before due to his condition and with no other local team able to meet his needs, and after numerous failed attempts, George finally got to play!!

The project has helped children be physically active, it's given children of the club and community something of value in their football journey. The football fun day brought in 17 new players!

Ysgol Gymuned Y Fali-Cookery Project- £500

In the spring term the children set about clearing and weeding the school garden so that they can plant different herbs, vegetables and fruit bushes. They also purchased the equipment needed for making food.

Bespoke gardening and cooking lessons were a key to the success and development of many of the children, including pupils with additional learning needs.

Parents and volunteers from the local community helped in the school garden, ensuring that their expertise and knowledge were passed on to the children.

Working to the schools class themes for each term, we were able to offer the children many opportunities to bake, cook and make different dishes. The children of Years 5 and 6 planned, prepared and cooked a roast dinner for themselves as part of their work on the Titanic. Years 3 and 4 prepared a traditional Welsh tea to complete their project with creative schools.

The children have learned valuable life skills. Ysgol Gymuned y Fali has also been successful in cooking competitions over the last year, coming first and second throughout Anglesey in the Cogurdd Competition.





Cysylltu â'r Henoed - LIAB Y Fali Cyfarfodydd Cymdeithasol Te Pryn hawn

Cynhaliwyd cyfarfodydd prynhawn misol yn Hyb Cymunedol LIAB Y Fali ar gyfer trigolion oedrannus Caergybi, Y Fali, Bodedern, Bryngwran, Caergeiliog, a Llanfaelog. Cynhaliwyd y sesiynau gan grŵp o tua 5 o wifoddolwyr gyda rhwng 12-15 o bobl yn mynychu pob sesiwn.



Roedd y sesiynau ar gyfer pobl dros 75 oed sy'n byw ar eu pen eu hunain, a all fod yn ynysig, yn agored i niwed, yn unig, neu mewn angen. Gwariwyd yr arian ar ddarparu te prynhawn a'r cyfle i'r rhai oedd yn mynychu gyfarfod yn gymdeithasol, creu ffrindiau newydd a chael rhywle cynnes a chroesawgar i fynychu'n rheolaidd.



LEGO CHURCH- St Edern's Church Bodedern £700



4 volunteers lead the sessions in the Memorial Hall, Bodedern. The group had a lot of craft materials and some Lego, however the grant enabled the group to buy more Lego, blocks for young children, food and drink, and rent the hall through the winter months.

A large number of families attended from the age of 3 to a grandmother in her 60s. In some sessions there were 3 generations of one family attending.

The children have enjoyed spending time with each other outside of school. Parents and grandparents



have been grateful for having somewhere to take their children and be able to spend time with them and to encourage them to try something new. The sessions have provided valuable socialising opportunities for everyone who attends and the children and adults enjoy learning about stories from the bible!

Contact the Elderly – RAF Valley

Afternoon Tea Social Gatherings

The monthly afternoon gatherings were held at the RAF Valley Community Hub for elderly residents of Holyhead, Valley, Bodedern, Bryngwran, Caergeiliog, and Llanfaelog. The sessions were run by a group of around 5 volunteers with between 12-15 people attending each session.



Sessions were for people over 75 years of age who live alone, who may be isolated, vulnerable, lonely, or in need. The money was spent on providing an afternoon tea and the opportunity for those attending to meet socially, create new friends and have somewhere warm and welcoming to attend on a regular basis.

The project sat well with the priorities of the Alliance in developing warm spaces and reducing the impacts of the cost of living, through providing food and enabling people to come and sit somewhere warm, reducing their energy costs. The project also promotes the use of community spaces and provided opportunities for volunteering locally!

The project works within the framework of the national scheme Re-engage which '**provides vital, life-enhancing social connections for older people at a time in their lives when their social circles are diminishing**'.

Prosiectau Cyllid Cychwynnol 2024



Clwb Cerdd Ysgol Uwchradd Bodedern

Dyfarnwyd £2,348 i brynu cit drymiau electronig ar gyfer y Clwb Cerdd. Mae'r Clwb Cerdd yn glwb sydd ar gael i holl ddisgyblion YUB. Mae gwersi offerynnol yn cael eu cynnig yn yr ysgol ond mae'n rhaid i ddisgyblion dalu am y gwersi hyn, a nid yw pawb yn gallu fforddio gwersi, sy'n aml yn golygu eu bod yn colli allan. Mae'r clwb cerdd yn rhad ac am ddim i bawb, ac mae disgyblion yn cael y cyfle i ddefnyddio a dysgu unrhyw offeryn y maent ei eisiau. Dros y blynnyddoedd mae'r Clwb wedi rhoi hyder, sgiliau newydd a phrofiadau bythgoiadwy i'r disgyblion.



Clwb Ffermwyr Ifanc Bodedern

Wedi derbyn £3374 gan y Gynghrair i brynu gwisgoedd, offer llwyfan, hyfforddiant i wirfoddolwyr a lluniaeth. Bydd hyn oll yn cael ei ddefnyddio tuag at ddigwyddiadau mwyaf y flwyddyn y clwb – yr Eisteddfod a'r Rali, lle byddant yn cystadlu mewn nifer o gystadlaethau.

Mae tua 45 o bobl ifanc wedi ymuno â'r clwb eleni ac mae tua 30 o bobl ifanc rhwng 13 a 30 oed yn mynchu'n wythnosol.

Roedd Eisteddfod y Ffermwyr Ifanc ar Faes Sioe Mona ar y 19eg o Hydref, darparwyd eitemau ar gyfer canu, siarad, dawnsio, meimio i gerddoriaeth, deuawdau doniol a llawer mwy. Os yn llwyddiannus - bydd rhai o'r eitemau yn mynd ymlaen i gystadlu yn Eisteddfod Ffermwyr Ifanc Cymru sy'n cael ei ddarlledu ar S4C.

Mae'r clwb yn gwneud defnydd o adeiladau cymunedol, yn eu defnyddio fel hybiau ac yn manteisio ar leoliadau eu pentrefi. Maen nhw wedi newid eu man ymgynnill i neuadd bentref Bodedern.



Clwb y Cob, Y Fali

Wedi derbyn £300 tuag at gostau eu cyfarfodydd ar gyfer Hydref a Thachwedd. Mae'r grŵp yn agored i bobl dros 50 oed yn yr ardal, gan gyfarfod yng Ngwesty'r Fali bob mis i gymdeithasu ac i dderbyn sgyrsiau gan asiantaethau fel Heddlu Gogledd Cymru, Safonau Masnach a Chyngor Sir Ynys Môn. Mae aelodau yn derbyn lluniaeth ysgafn a daw costau siaradwyr, rhedeg y clwb o danysgrifiad blynnyddol a chodi arian. Bydd yr arian hwn yn helpu i leihau baich rhai o'r costau hyn i'r aelodau.

Codi Ymwybyddiaeth am y Gynghrair

Ar gyfer y rownd ariannu hon, trafododd y Gynghrair am sut i godi proffil y gwaith y maent yn ei wneud. Mae ganddynt grŵp facebook gweithredol gyda 190 o aelodau lle mae'n yn rhannu gwybodaeth am brosiectau'r Gynghrair ond hefyd am ymgynghoriadau lleol a materion o fewn y ward.

Mae'r grŵp yn awyddus i hyrwyddo eu gwaith ac wedi dewis prynu baneri a gasebo gyda logo'r Gynghrair wedi'i argraffu arnynt. Defnyddir y rhain ar gyfer digwyddiadau cyhoeddus a gobeithio y byddant yn helpu i roi cyhoeddusrwydd ehangach i'r Gynghrair. Bydd pob aelod yn cael ei annog i ddefnyddio'r offer i helpu i ledaenu'r gwaith!

Seed funded projects 2024



Music Club Ysgol Uwchradd Bodedern

Were awarded £2,348 to purchase an electronic drum kit for the Music Club. The Music Club is a club available to all YUB pupils. There are instrument lessons offered at the school but pupils have to pay for these lessons, and there are a number of pupils who cannot afford lessons, often meaning that they miss out. The music club is free for everyone, and pupils have the opportunity to use and learn any instrument they want. Over the years the Club has given the pupils confidence, new skills and unforgettable experiences.



Bodedern Young Farmers

Received £3374 from the Alliance to purchase costumes, stage equipment, training for volunteers and refreshments. This will all be used towards the club's biggest events of the year- the Eisteddfod and the Rally, where they will compete in a number of competitions. Around 45 young people have joined the club this year and approximately 30 young people attend weekly between the ages of 13 and 30.

The Young Farmers Eisteddfod was at Mona Showground on the 19th of October, items were provided for singing, speaking, dancing, mime to music, funny duets and much more. If successful - some of the items will go on to compete in the Welsh Young Farmers Eisteddfod which is broadcast on S4C.

The club are making use of community buildings, using them as hubs and taking advantage of their village locations. They have changed their gathering place to Bodedern village hall.



Clwb y Cob, Valley

Received £300 towards the costs of their meetings for October and November. The group is open to people over 50 in the area, meeting in the Valley Hotel each month to socialise and to receive talks from agencies such as North Wales Police, Trading Standards and Anglesey County Council. Members receive light refreshments and the costs of speakers and running the club comes from an annual subscription and fundraising. This money will help to reduce the burden of some of these costs for the members.

Raising Awareness about the Alliance

For this round of funding the Alliance discussed how they could raise the profile of the work that they do. The group has an active facebook group with 190 members where it share information about Alliance projects but also about local consultations and issues within the ward. The group is keen to widen its presence and have opted to buy pop-up banners and a gazebo with the Alliance logo printed on them. These will be used for public events and will hopefully help to publicise the Alliance more widely. Member will all be encouraged to use the equipment to help spread the word!

Updates on the projects



The Alliance released their first round of seed funding of £4,000 in December 2023. They funded 6 community projects that help them to achieve their priorities. Below is an overview of some of the funded projects....

Cylch Meithrin Bryngwran

Were awarded £1,000 to try and help increase the numbers attending the Cylch Meithrin and Cylch Ti a Fi. To do this the group felt that they needed extra resources and the application included the cost to purchase art resources, exercise equipment and food for those attending. The Cylch Meithrin also received funding to bring in partners to hold sessions for the children through the medium of Welsh. We look forward to receiving feedback on how this developed.



Rhosneigr Village Hall - Christmas spirit

The Christmas spirit event was a one off and provided presents for the children along with a free visit to Santa. The Hall provided entertainment and refreshments and we also partnered with a local business (Sandymount house) for the mince pies.

Approximately 70 children attended the event which not only helped towards the cost of living but provided a break for families with a free night out. The £200 for this event enabled us to give a more generous present to the children.



The actual turnout of people gave us an insight as to the relevance and need of this sort of event. The feedback from people on the night was evidence enough that we had met a real need to helping families suffering in the cost of living crises at this time of year.



Ysgol y Ffridd Gwalchmai - London Trip!

The date has been set for the London trip, the train tickets have been purchased, hotel booked for the Earls court area, tickets to see Mrs Doubtfire at the West End and a ride on the London eye and an open top bus tour!

Everyone is looking forward to the trip and the grant has enabled a discount of £52 per child. We look forward to further updates on their return, enjoy!



Christmas Hampers Project

Llanfaelog Community Council were awarded funding to create a Christmas Hamper project for the most vulnerable in their community.

Residents who were struggling over the festive period due to the cost-of-living crisis or through living alone would be eligible to receive hampers under the scheme, 35 were distributed within the community by volunteers.

The project falls under the priority of the impact of the Cost of Living Crisis.

Llanfaelog Hub

Derbyniodd y neuadd £900 i newid y goleuadau yn y Neuadd, gan alluogi'r neuadd i gynnal mwy o grwpiau/gweithdai, a chynyddu ymgysylltiad cymdeithasol. Seed funded projects 2024



The Alliance released their second round of seed funding of £10,000 in Summer 2024. They funded 5 community projects that help them to achieve their priorities. Below is an overview of some of the funded projects....

Cylch Brain Bach


The Cylch wanted to develop the outside play area and strengthen the connection with the school and community. The funding was used to purchase bikes, scooters, balance boards, multi kitchen equipment for children to share, play and interact, developing communication and social skills. They received £2,550



Ysgol Y Ffridd

The pupils will work on an art project with a local artist, Andy Birch. The project will see the children taking part in graffiti workshops to produce murals within the school grounds. The murals will be on show for the Community and pupils to enjoy.

The graffiti workshops are due to take place on the 18th November. We look forward to seeing the end result!



Llanfaelog Hub

The hall received £900 to replace the lighting at the Hall, allowing the hall to run more groups/workshops, and increasing social engagement. The Hall already holds various events such as choir practice, theatre productions and will facilitate a youth drama workshop with the help of the new equipment.

The fund also supported the creation of a newsletter, produced by volunteers. The newsletter will share information 'What's On' in the area with residents. A draft of the newsletter was launched at their autumn fair in September and the local community were asked for feedback and opinions to ensure that it was meeting the need and also to recruit more volunteers. Volunteers from the Hall committee and two new volunteers helped distribute 500 copies of the newsletter by hand.



Neuadd Yr Eglwys, Bryngwran

The Church Hall in Bryngwran is the centre of the community. They received £1,860 to repair the heating, hot water and the toilet in the building. This will enable the group to run 'chat and cup' sessions for those who feel lonely and isolated, run a charity shop once a week and open the hall for future events.

Capel Engedi

Received £1,285 for carpet, paint and upgrade windows. This will bring the building to a standard to and will enable them to continue offering coffee mornings, raise money for charities, bring the community together, and reduce loneliness and isolation within the older community. The group is now looking at holding keep fit sessions, and have invited guest speakers to come and talk to the group.

The Alliance received SPF funding from Anglesey Council and Menter Môn and a community transport grant from Medrwn Môn to employ a driver for 16 hours a week. A timetable was created to replicate the previous bus times through the villages in the Ward.

However, following further feedback from the community and partners to the project it was decided to extend the service into the neighbouring ward of Bro'r Llynnoedd to cover the village of Bodedern.

This is a great example of community led action, with the Alliance not only working in partnership with groups in their own ward, but also with neighbouring Alliances and local statutory services to provide a creative solution to community identified needs.

To cover the short-term impacts it was decided to work with the Alliance to pilot a project in Crigyll ward. This would see a partnership created between the Crigyll Alliance, the Iorwerth Arms and Bryngwran Good Turn Scheme to trial a community 'bus' service that would replace the one that had been lost due to the cuts.

The Crigyll Alliance had identified transport as one of their main priorities, and the Bryngwran Good Turn Scheme had an electric vehicle that was available for use 3 mornings a week. The Iorwerth Arms agreed to be the host employer for a paid driver, using an agreement they were able to develop from the model used between the Seiriol Alliance and Canolfan Beaumaris.

I have been so cut off from everything since the bus service stopped. Having transport to link me to the bus services will give me back my independence.

Dichonoldeb Parc Chwarae

Derbyniodd Cyngor Cymuned Pentraeth £700 i gynnal astudiaeth ddichonoldeb i ddarn o dir a oedd wedi ei adnabod gan y gymuned ar gyfer parc chwarae yn yr ardal. Mae dros 100 o blant oed ysgol gynradd ym Mhentraeth ond nid oes cyfleusterau chwarae ar gael iddynt yn y pentref. Cynhaliwyd digwyddiadau ymgynghori gyda'r cyhoedd ac ar ôl llawer o drafod teimlai'r cyhoedd nad oedd yr ardal a nodwyd yn addas ar gyfer parc chwarae ac mae trafodaethau'n parhau ynghylch dewis arall.

Bu Digwyddiad y Nadolig y llynedd yn gatalydd wrth ddod â Moelfre a'r ardaloedd cyfagos ynghyd i greu ysbryd cymunedol bywiog, gan arwain at newid mawr mewn agweddau'n lleol a defnyddio'r Neuadd Bentref fel canolbwyt i'r gymuned. Derbyniodd y grŵp £1,000 mewn arian cyfatebol.

Funding projects against priorities

The Alliance released their first round of seed funding in September 2022 and a second in December 2023. They funded 7 community projects that help them to achieve their priorities. Below is an overview of some of the funded projects

Speed Reduction signs- Pentraeth

Speeding and traffic were identified as a priority for the Alliance, especially through the village of Pentraeth. The Community Council had already made some progress in gathering information about speed reduction measures, including flashing speed signs. The Alliance match funded the purchase of the signs, which are intended to improve driver behaviour and provide ongoing useful data to help evidence further traffic calming measures that may be required throughout the village.



Play Park Feasibility



One of the priorities of the Alliance was playgrounds, play parks and play areas. Pentraeth Community Council received £700 to carry out a feasibility study into an area of land that had been identified by the community for a play park in the area. There are over 100 children of primary school age in Pentraeth but there are no play amenities available to them in the village. Consultation events were held with the public and after much deliberation the public felt that the identified area was not suitable for a play park and discussions are still ongoing about an alternative.

Christmas Fayre

Moelfre Community Christmas Event was established post Covid to respond to feedback from the community that they wanted events in Moelfre that would bring people together as a community.

The Christmas Event last year was a catalyst in bringing Moelfre and the surrounding areas together in creating a vibrant community spirit, resulting in a sea-change of attitudes locally and using the Village Hall as a hub for the community. The group received £1,000 in match funding.



Tennis sessions for young people - Caru Benllech

Received funding to provide sessions for young people to try tennis and support the costs associated with taking part in the sport. The group found that local families were unable to pay for the sessions for their children to take part, especially after Covid and because of the cost of living crisis. This project aimed to widen provision for teenagers due to the lack of activities for them locally.



Cynghrair Lligwy

Cyllid i greu gardd gymunedol i bawb!



Amlygodd yr ymgynghoriadau Llunio Lle a arweiniodd at sefydlu Cynghrair Lligwy, fod trigolion yn meddwl bod Moelfre yn flŵr, ac nad oedd ganddo ganolbwyt i drigolion y gymuned ymgynnll. Dywedodd preswylwyr fod llawer o bobl yn cyfarfod yn yr awyr agored yn eu gerddi yn ystod Covid. Dyma lle cyfarfu rhai â'u cymdogion am y tro cyntaf, ac roedd yn rhywbeth yr oeddent yn teimlo oedd yn eu cadw mewn cysylltiad yn ystod y cyfnod cloi, a bod hwn bellach wedi'i golli.



Sicrhaodd Medrwn Môn gyllid gan BIPBC i ddatblygu mannau gwyrdd rhwng cenedlaethau ar draws yr Ynys. Gwnaeth grŵp Moelfre gais i fod yn un o'r rhain ac yn dilyn ymlaen o'r mapio cymunedol sicrhaodd y grŵp yr arian i symud y prosiect yn ei flaen.

Bu pobl o bob oed o Foelfre yn ymwneud â dylunio, cynllunio a gweithredu'r ardd. Fe wnaeth y prosiect reciriwtio 9 o wirfoddolwyr, gweithio gyda Neuadd Gymunedol Moelfre, y PCSO lleol, grŵp dros 50 oed ac ysgol gynradd.

Bydd yr agwedd sy'n pontio'r cenedlaethau yn helpu i wella perthnasoedd ar draws cenedlaethau a rhannu sgiliau a straeon Rwy'n ffordd anffurfiol. Derbyniodd Gwirfoddolwyr y Gynghrair hefyd hyfforddiant ar Brofiadau Niweidiol yn ystod Plentyndod gan lechyd Cyhoeddus Cymru fel rhan o ffocws y cynllun rhwng cenedlaethau.

Ymgynghorwyd ymhellach â phobl Moelfre a'r gymuned gyfagos. Dywedodd pobl yr hoffent gael man awyr agored diogel a hygyrch i bob oedran ddod at ei gilydd a'i fwynhau. Roedd yr awgrymiadau'n cynnwys ardal gyda meinciau a rhandiroedd wedi'u paentio, yn seiliedig ar brosiectau cymunedol tebyg fel yr ardd gymunedol yn Amlwch.

Lligwy Alliance

Funding to create a community garden for all!



The Place Shaping consultations that resulted in the setting up of the Lligwy Alliance, highlighted that residents thought that Moelfre was untidy, and had no focal point for community residents to gather. Residents stated that during Covid many people met outdoors in their gardens. This is where some met their neighbours for the first time, and was something that they felt kept them connected during the lockdown, and that this has now been lost.



Medrwn Môn's secured funding from BCUHB to develop intergenerational green spaces across the Island. The Moelfre group applied to be one of these and following on from the community mapping the group secured the money to take the project forward.

People of all ages from Moelfre were involved in the designing, planning and implementation of the garden. The project recruited 9 volunteers, worked with Moelfre Community Hall, the local PCSO, over 50's group and primary school.

The intergenerational aspect will help to improve relationships across generations and the sharing of skill and stories in an informal way. Volunteers of the Alliance also received training on Adverse Childhood Experiences from Public Health Wales as part of the intergenerational focus of the scheme.



Further consultation with the people of Moelfre and the surrounding community took place. People stated that they would like a safe and accessible outdoor area for all ages to come together and enjoy. Suggestions included an area with painted benches and allotments, based on similar community projects like the community garden in Amlwch.

Amlygodd yr ymgynghoriadau Llunio Lle a arweiniodd at sefydlu Cynghrair Lligwy, fod trigolion yn meddwl y gellid defnyddio hybiau cymunedol yn ehangach ar gyfer y bobl yn y gymuned. Yn ystod 2022 gyda chyllid gan Medrwn Môn, sefydlodd gwirfoddolwyr Gofod Cynnes, yn Neuadd Goffa Pentraeth, lle gwahoddwyd pobl am baned, cacen a sgwrs ar brynhawn dydd Mawrth i gymdeithasu tra hefyd yn lleihau eu costau gwresogi yn ystod yr argywng costau byw.



Mae'r sgrysiau ar hanes lleol wedi bod yn boblogaidd iawn ac roedd y trigolion yn ei chael yn hynod ddiddorol. Mae'r digwyddiadau wedi denu 25 o bobl newydd, rhai ohonynt yn mynchu'r gofod cynnes wythnosol. Ni allai'r digwyddiadau hyn ddigwydd heb y tîm bach o 5 gwirfoddolwr.

Mae'r digwyddiadau arbennig hyn wedi bod yn gyfle i annog mwy o bobl i fynychu digwyddiadau yn y neuadd, gan ddod â phobl at ei gilydd yn gymdeithasol, cynyddu ymwybyddiaeth o'r neuadd ac arddangos y cyfleusterau sydd wedi'u gwella'n fawr yn y ddwy flynedd ddiwethaf, gyda gwaith pellach i'w ymestyn. cyfleusterau sydd ar y gweill ar hyn o bryd.

Mae'r grŵp yn gobeithio parhau i gynnal digwyddiadau eraill yn y prynhawn gan gynnwys gwneud plannwr bylbiau'r gwanwyn a gwneud torch Nadolig. Maent yn bwriadu ymestyn y rhaglen newydd y tu hwnt i ddiwedd y flwyddyn.

Mae'r grŵp wedi bod yn llwyddiannus iawn ac nid oedd bobl Pentraeth am golli'r grŵp felly fe wnaethant barhau ar gost fechan a gymhorthdal gan Neuadd Goffa Pentraeth. Ar ôl siarad ag aelodau, awgrymwyd bod angen gwneud y grŵp yn fwy ddiddorol er mwyn denu fwy o aelodau, felly gwnaeth Neuadd Bentref Pentraeth gais am arian gan Gynghrair Lligwy i ehangu'r sesiynau i fwy o aelodau drwy wahodd siaradwyr gwadd i'r sesiynau.

Lligwy Alliance

Increasing local knowledge and friendship, while reducing energy!

The Place Shaping consultations that resulted in the setting up of the Lligwy Alliance, highlighted that residents thought that community hubs could be used more widely for the people in the community. During 2022 with funding from Medrwn Môn, volunteers set up a Warm Space, in Pentraeth Memorial Hall, where people were invited for a cuppa, cake and a chat on a Tuesday afternoon to socialise while also reducing their heating costs during the cost of living crisis.



The talks on local history have proved to be very popular and residents found it extremely interesting. The events have attracted 25 new people, some of who are attending the weekly warm space. These events couldn't happen without the small team of 5 volunteers.

These special events have been an opportunity to encourage more people to attend events in the hall, bringing people together socially, increase awareness about the hall and to showcase the facilities which have been greatly improved in the past couple of years, with further work to extend facilities currently underway.

The group are hoping to continue to host other afternoon events including making a Spring bulb garden planter and Christmas wreath making. They are looking to extend the new program beyond the year end.

The group has been very successful and residence of Pentraeth did not want to lose the group so they continued at a small cost that was subsidised by Pentraeth Memorial Hall. After talking to members, they suggested they needed to make the group interesting to attract more members, so Pentraeth Village Hall applied for funding from the Lligwy Alliance to expand the sessions to more members by inviting guest speakers to the sessions.



Cyngor Cymuned Moelfre

Wedi derbyn £2900 ar gyfer gosod arwyddion gwybodaeth dwyieithog ar dirnodau lleol ym Moelfre sy'n cysylltu'n ôl i wefan gyda chodau QR, yn rhoi gwybodaeth am hanes a diwylliant lleol. Bydd yr arwyddion hefyd yn cynnwys yr enwau Cymraeg gwreiddiol ar gyfer y tirnodau a gollwyd dros y blynnyddoedd. Y gobaith yw cynyddu gwybodaeth am yr ardal a chadw hunaniaeth ddiwylliannol, ar gyfer ymwelwyr a phobl leol.

Neuadd Penrhoslligwy, Brynrefail

Mae'r neuadd wedi cael rheolaeth newydd yn ddiweddar ac maen't edrych i gynyddu'r defnydd o'r neuadd. Maen nhw wedi derbyn £600 ar gyfer paent i adnewyddu ystafell sydd ddim mewn defnydd yn yr adeilad, oherwydd lleithder. Mae achos y lleithder wedi ei drwsio, felly trwy beintio'r ystafell bydd yn caniatáu mwy o ddefnydd ohoni, ar gyfer gweithgareddau megis Chwist, nosweithiau cwis misol a yoga.

Neuadd Goffa Pentraeth

Yn ystod 2022 gyda chyllid gan Medrwn Môn, sefydlodd gwirfoddolwyr Gofod Cynnes yn Neuadd Goffa Pentraeth, lle gwahoddwyd pobl am baned, cacen a sgwrs. Cawsant £1000 gan Gyngahrain Lligwy i helpu i ddenu mwy o aelodau i ganolbwyt y gofod cynnes. Defnyddiwyd yr arian i wahodd siaradwyr gwadd, a ffilmiau am hanes a diwylliant lleol. Maent hefyd wedi cyflwyno gweithgareddau corfforol ar gyfer y sesiynau fel yoga cadair.

Cyngor Cymuned LlanfairME

Mae LlanfairME wedi derbyn £2000 tuag at radar cyflymder solar sy'n dangos y cyflymder y mae pobl yn gyrru, mae'r radar yn diolch iddynt neu'n eu rhybuddio am eu cyflymder. Mae lleihau cyflymder er budd y gymuned gyfan ac mae Benllech yn bentref prysur iawn yn enwedig yn ystod yr haf, a byddai'r radar cyflymder yn helpu i gadw cerddwyr a gyrrwyr eraill yn ddiogel. Gan ei fod yn cael ei bweru gan yr haul, mae'r arwydd yn gyfeillgar i'r amgylchedd ac nid yw'n costio dim i'w redeg.

Fair Nadolig Moelfre

Dyfarnodd cyngahrain Lligwy £1500 i Nadolig Cymunedol Moelfre tuag at gynnal ffair Nadolig i bobl yn ward Lligwy ac o'i chwmpas, i gynnwys arddangosfa Tân gwylt, gweithgareddau amrywiol trwy gydol y dydd, ac adloniant gan artistiaid lleol amrywiol, mae costau eraill yn cynnwys goleuadau Nadoligaidd, llogi systemau annerch cyhoeddus, llogi cyfleusterau fel Portaloo, ac argraffu rhagleni digwyddiadau ac ati.



Lligwy Alliance

Seed Funding Projects 2024

The Alliance released their second round of seed funding of £10,000 in July 2024. They funded 6 community projects that help them to achieve their priorities. Below is an overview of some of the funded projects....

Pentraeth Community Council

Were awarded £2000 towards purchasing and installing a new electronic speed sign on the A5025 to replace to current broken wooden sign. This area is a area hot spot for accidents where one resident was unfortunately struck by a car last year. Pentraeth was awarded funding previously for an electronic speed sign which has proved very successful in reducing vehicles speeding in this area, making the area safer for residents.



Moelfre Community Council

Have been awarded £2900 for Bilingual information signs to be erected at local landmarks in Moelfre that link back to a website with QR codes, giving information about the local history and culture. The signs will also include the original Welsh names for the landmarks, that have been lost over the years. The hope is to increase knowledge of the area and preserve cultural identity, for visitors and local people.

Penrhoslligwy Hall, Brynrefail



Has recently had a change in hall management and are looking to increase the usage of the hall. They have received £600 for paint to refurb an unused room in the building, caused by damp. The cause of the damp has been fixed, so by painting the room it will allow it to be used more, for activities such as Whist, monthly quiz nights and yoga.

Pentraeth Memorial Hall

During 2022 with funding from Medrwn Môn, volunteers set up a Warm Space in Pentraeth Memorial Hall, where people were invited for a cuppa, cake and a chat. They were awarded £1000 from Lligwy Alliance to help attract more members to the warm space's hub. The money was used to invite guest speakers, and films about the local history and culture. They have also introduced physical activities for the sessions such as chair yoga.

LlanfairME

LlanfairME have been awarded £2000 towards a solar speed radar that displays the speed people are driving at and thanks them or warns them of their speed. Reducing speed is in the interest of the whole community and Benllech specifically is a very busy village particularly during the summer, and the speed radar would help to keep pedestrians and other divers safe. Being solar powered, the sign is an environmentally friendly and doesn't cost anything to run.

Moelfre Christmas Festival

Lligwy Alliance awarded Moelfre Community Chritamas £1500 towards staging a Christmas fair for people in and around the Lligwy Ward. to include a firework display, various activities throughout the day, and entertainment by various local artists, other costs include festive lighting, hire of public address systems, hire of facilities such as portaloo, and printing of event programs etc

Edrychodd y sesiwn ar flaenoriaethau'r Gynghrair a gofyn i'r bobl ifanc a oeddent yn meddwl yr hoffent helpu'r Gynghrair i'w cyflawni yn ogystal ag archwilio'r sgiliau oedd ganddynt i helpu i wneud hyn.

Beth ddysgon nhw?

Ymunodd dros 70 o bobl ifanc â'r sesiynau. Dywedasant wrthym eu bod am i'r Gynghrair ddod i mewn i'r ysgol bob blwyddyn i siarad am syniadau gyda nhw. Fe ddywedon nhw hefyd fod angen mwy o gyfathrebu a chyhoeddusrwydd am yr hyn y mae'r Gynghrair yn ei wneud ac yn ei wneud a sut y gall pobl ifanc gymryd rhan.

Dyweddodd y bobl ifanc wrthym fod ganddynt y sgiliau i gyfathrebu ag eraill a'u hannog i fod yn rhan o'r gwaith, y sgiliau i helpu i godi arian ar gyfer prosiectau cymunedol ac roeddent yn barod i roi cyhoeddusrwydd i'r gwaith ar eu cyfryngau cymdeithasol.



Beth nesaf?

Roedd y bobl ifanc yn wirioneddol frwd frydig am waith y Gynghrair ac wedi mynegi y byddent yn awyddus i drefnu a chymryd rhan mewn sesiynau codi sbwriel lleol, chwilio am atebion i faterion trafnidiaeth, bod yn rhan o ddatblygiad/diweddaru part hollifanc yn eu harddegau ac archwilio datblygiad clwb beiciau yng Nghoed Curnol. Fe wnaeth 10 o'r bobl ifanc a gymerodd ran yn y sesiwn yn Ysgol David Hughes hefyd wirfoddoli'n ddiweddar i fod ar y panel penderfynu ar gyfer Grant Gwirfoddoli Ieuenciad GwirVol Medrwn Môn lle dyfarnwyd cyllid i 5 prosiect cymunedol.

Aethwy Alliance

Involving young people

The Aethwy Alliance is keen to engage young people in the way that the Alliance develops. The Alliance priorities had been chosen as

- Transport
- Community Spaces
- Environment and
- Children and young people.

The group were keen to hear to voices of young people in the development of those priorities moving forward. This included understanding what young people thought about the chosen priorities as well as how they could help to develop projects and activities to help achieve those priorities.



What did they do?

Members of the Alliance worked with Medrwn Môn to arrange an engagement session with the young people at Ysgol David Hughes. The session looked at the priorities of the Alliance and asked the young people whether they thought they would like to help the Alliance to achieve them as well as exploring the skills that they had to help to do this

What did they learn?

Over 70 young people joined the sessions. They told us that they wanted the Alliance to come in to the school every year to talk about ideas with them.

They also said that more communication and publicity is needed about what the Alliance is and does and how young people can get involved.

The young people told us that they had the skills to communicate with others and encourage them to be a part of the work, the skills to help fundraise for community projects and were willing to publicise the work on their social media



What next?

The young people were really enthusiastic about the work of the Alliance and have expressed that they would be keen to organise and take part in local litter picks, look for solutions to transport issues, to be part of development/update of a teenage zone and to explore the development of a bike club at Coed Cynrol. 10 of the young people who took part in the session in Ysgol David Hughes also recently volunteered to be on the decision making panel for Medrwn Môn's GwirVol Youth Volunteering Grant where they awarded funding to 5 community projects.



Aethwy Alliance



Prioritising the wellbeing of young people!

CELS Character Education & Life Skills was established in response to the increasing challenges faced by children and young people, which became more pronounced during the Covid-19 pandemic. CELS applied to the Aethwy Alliance under the children and young people priority and received seed funding in the Summer of 2024.

CELS held 4 sessions in the ward- 2 in Menai Bridge and 2 in Llanfairpwll. These included team-building sessions, games and sports activities and well-being workshops focused on developing resilience, self-esteem, and emotional well-being.

The sessions helped the children to develop valuable life skills including **teamwork, problem-solving, and self-confidence**. Sessions were free to attend and used community venues and outdoor spaces that were easily accessible.

135

children and young people from Menai Bridge, Llanfairpwll, and surrounding areas took part in the sessions

4

new volunteering opportunities for local teenagers, who assisted in leading sessions, organising activities, and supporting the children during the camps.

69%

of the children who took part in the sessions were Welsh Speakers

6%

of participants had additional learning or physical needs, and activities were adapted to ensure inclusivity and engagement for all



Parent feedback : '*[My son] was reluctant to go to the camps as 'he didn't like sports' and had had some bad experiences at another holiday type camp. I just about managed to get him to go through the gates in which I immediately felt at ease by the warm welcome by the instructors. Having spotted a friend, he went straight in and sat with them.*

When picking him up I was expecting tears as we had last time, but there weren't any. He was so happy and spoke of all the games he had played and which he had won. He was pleased it wasn't sport focused, but was able to take part in fun games with new people'

Seed funded projects 2024

The Alliance released their second round of seed funding of £14,000 in June 2024. They funded 7 community projects that help them to achieve their priorities. Below is an overview of the funded projects....

Penmynydd Almshouse Initiative

Received £1,200 to carry out an environmental study that would support the business plan to apply for funding to develop this creative housing solution in the village.

The group wants to create high quality housing project to help young people and families to find their first home in the village. These reports are the first step in a £600,000 project!

Canolfan Penmynydd

The group secured funding from the Alliance to carry out upgrades and improvements to Canolfan Penmynydd. The upgrades included repairing the windows and painting inside and outside. The Canolfan is the only community building in the village and is home to local craft fayres, parties, Community Council meetings and Young Farmer's meetings.



Menai Bridge Cricket Club



Received funding from the Alliance towards works at their grounds as part of a bigger re-development of the Cricket Club. The money will be used towards tree removal and storage containers on site. The bigger vision of the Club is to create a community hub for Menai Bridge and to widen access to the community to the outdoor and extended indoor facilities that they are creating.

Llewod Y Bont Rugby Club

The Alliance funded the group to improve access at their rugby club in Menai Bridge. The group wanted to increase their mixed ability offer by building ramp access to their clubhouse. The ramp will ensure that the rugby club can continue to be inclusive and increase the number of mixed ability players at the club.



Neuadd Goffa Llanfairpwll



Had a contribution from the Alliance towards batteries for their solar panels. The hall has had significant investment over the recent years and is a busy community hub. The investment in the batteries means that the reductions in utility costs can be passed on to the community groups using the hall in the future.

The batteries will also enable the group to reduce its own running costs, making it more sustainable in the longer term

Menai Bridge War Memorial Community Centre

The group had funding to erect a large noticeboard outside the hall and two noticeboards in the entrance to the building to show residents what activities are being held in the hall. They also had money towards creating an online booking system for the hall and upgrading their website. Other project costs included the creation of a mural on the outside of the building, the development of a panad and sgwrs session, and monthly cinema clubs!

Bro Aberffraw

Defnyddio fideo i gysylltu'r gymuned

Bro Aberffraw

Using video to connect the community!

The Bro Aberffraw Alliance elected a chair in June 2024. The new Chair was keen to make sure that everyone in the community had the opportunity to engage with the direction and priorities of the Alliance outside of the normal meeting structure.

Medrwn Môn connected the Chair with Crefft Media and they worked together to draft questions that they would ask the community.

The Chair of the Alliance and Local Asset Co-ordinator for the ward, Anne Jones visited a number of areas and spoke to people on the street in Hermon, Aberffraw, Newborough and Bodorgan as well as Santes Dwynwen Primary School.



The following were the questions that each participant was asked.

1. What is good about living in the Bro Aberffraw area/ what are the challenges?
2. What would be your top 3 things to improve or change to make a difference to your well-being and quality of life?
3. If you had a pot of funding to improve life here, what would you spend it on?

The video was shared with the full Alliance in their meeting at the beginning of November.

Feedback from the group was positive and they were pleased that this way of engaging with the community resulted in representation from those who haven't yet attended Alliance meetings. This way of working has also proved to residents that they can take part in any way that they choose to do so and promotes the ethos of Alliances using as many ways as possible to involve their communities in decision making.

The video will be shared as far and wide as possible as an example of how an Alliance can get to those harder to engage people in the community and use their ideas and comments to develop community priorities.

'Making the effort to come to talk to us in our communities, goes a long way. I feel now that I have been included in the work of the Alliance, meetings aren't for me!'

Cae Chwarae Llangaffo

Bro Aberffraw Alliance

Seed funded projects 2024

Llangaffo Clwb Hamdden

Received £310 to buy Bingo equipment, projector and screen for the club, this will give the people of Llangaffo the opportunity to socialise, make new friends and enjoy activities in the community.

Llangaffo Play Area

£2,200 was received towards the purchase of multi-sensory equipment for children living with neurodiversity, and a basketball for the play area, the aim of the project is communication and social skills focusing on inclusion for all.



Llangaffo Village Hall

£1,100 to replace the old wooden chairs and tables with new padded seating, having comfortable furniture makes it more inviting and pleasant for people using the facilities.

Clwb Ni Dwyran- Airfix and Youth Club

The club received £1,405 in total to run the Airfix model club and equipment for the new youth group in Hen Fecws. Both clubs give young people in the village the opportunity to meet in a safe place and have fun whilst learning new skills such as team building and problem solving skills.



Tal Y Sarn Noticeboard and Newsletter

Had £1,398 towards a notice board providing vital information for the community and giving other groups and businesses in the area the opportunity to advertise, promote local events. Anyone within the Alliance area is welcome to use it. The funding also supported the **Rhosyr Ratl** (twice yearly magazine) which includes events, community businesses, articles puzzles and local activities and walks!



Bodorgan Hearing Loop & Chiropody chair


£2,500 towards installing a hearing loop system will enhance the enjoyment for the users of the building who experience hearing loss, the loop will be available in 3 main areas. The centre also received funding to provide a specialist chair for podiatry treatment, this will be available for use across the Ward.

Newborough Parc Y Plant

£2,100 to purchase goal posts for the park, targeting the older children of Newborough who have previously not had any proper way of playing football in the park. Repairs to the park have been paid for so that younger and older children can once again enjoy the park safely

Newborough Youth Club

The group received £770. The club will be held at the Eglwys Fach Hall, the funding will pay for a youth leader and assistant to hold sessions for young people, activities, fun and games!



Aberffraw Village Hall Improvements

£940 granted to purchase IT equipment, training for volunteers to use and create resources and posters to promote events in the hall and locally. The volunteers had the opportunity to learn a new skill.


Cyngor Cymuned Llanddaniel FAB

Bodowyr Alliance

Seed funded projects 2024

Brynsiencyn Community Council - Bryn In Bloom

Received £300 to buy gardening equipment and supplies for community volunteers. The idea was to bring people of all ages from the community together to organise flower displays through the village- outside the Ganolfan, by the Groelson pub and by the War Memorial. It is hoped that this will encourage other volunteers to look at further planting in the future.

Ganolfan Brynsiencyn

Received £1,280 in total to purchase bingo equipment and a PA system for the Hall. The Bingo sees people from all ages coming together in the Hall weekly and proceeds are used to hold other community events and trips for members. They also bought new folding tables and chairs. The Ganolfan is being refurbished and the new equipment will be able to be stored in a room outside of the main hall, saving space for other activities.

Canolfan Brynsiencyn Children's Group

Received £840 to buy a screen and projector to be able to hold community film nights in the Hall. The Ganolfan would be responsible for the licensing requirements and the children for organising the films. The young people are also thinking of new ways to generate money to keep the nights going, including buying a popcorn machine and selling refreshments!

Llanddaniel FAB Community Council

Received £1,900 to create a daffodil planting project. The funded was used to buy daffodil bulbs, planters and refreshments. 70 people took part on the day and planted 1000 bulbs by 11am! The event was an intergenerational activity with residents working with Ysgol parc y Bont.



Llanddaniel FAB Community Council

Received £484 to purchase extra seating to put in the community playground, where there is already some picnic tables. This will allow more people to come together to eat picnics in the playground, socialise and spend time in the outdoors.

Llanfihangel Esceifiog Community Council

Received £2,500 towards the cost of replacing the see-saw in the park in Gaerwen. The playing field is extremely popular both with villagers and with people from outside the area. This will help to make sure the equipment is modern & fit for purpose and will be maintained by the Community council.

Cymuned CELS Community

Received £2,000 to hold sessions across the ward that helped the children to develop valuable skills including teamwork, problem-solving & self-confidence. Sessions are free to attend and used community venues an outdoor spaces that were easily accessible.



Ysgol Parc Y Bont

Received £2,485 to purchase goals and picnic/activity tables for the school playing field. The equipment will be used by other groups who use the school grounds including Young Farmers and Clwb Gwawr and will support community events such as coffee afternoons!

Holyhead Alliance

Seed funded projects 2024

Gwelfor Majorettes & Holyhead Sapphires Majorettes

Received £3,438 between them to buy batons, pumps and equipment for their members to be able to take part without worrying about the cost. The groups wants to widen access to majorettes and increase the numbers of young people taking part in exercise and want to reduce barriers to joining by providing equipment free of charge to members

Over 65's Christmas Meal Project

Received £1,528 to purchase decorations and equipment to help run the annual free Christmas meal at the Holyhead Hotspur Football Clubhouse. The event is run by local volunteers and provides a meal, entertainment and gift to those who would otherwise be alone for Christmas .



Cae Cybi Playing Field Association

Received £3,488 match funding towards holding Play:Disrupt engagement sessions with the local community to find out what they want to see included in the revamp of the playing field in Treseifion. sessions planned for 16th November



Llaingoch Community Garden

Received £5,600 towards creating a garden space Llaingoch Community Hall. The grant will be used to buy a greenhouse, compost bins and gardening tools. The group plans to involve the wider community in developing a space for all to be in the outdoors.

Peibio Bowling Club

Were awarded £1,824 to tarmac the outside area around the bowling green, insulate and paint the Pavilion itself. The group meets every Sunday and Wednesday afternoon and is open for anyone to join. Bowling provides light exercise and companionship for its members, who use the Pavilion to enjoy a cup of tea or eat lunch together as well as bowling.

Anglesey Astronomical Society

Applied for £2102 to buy equipment including a smart telescope, Samsung tablet, batteries and electronic camera to support their outreach programme and community engagement initiatives. The funding would also be used to buy uniforms for volunteers and Young Astronomer Club members to create a sense of identity for the group.



Draig Goch Boxing Club

Received £3,989 towards equipment for the club. The club is open to children and young people from the age of 8, and sessions are run Monday, Wednesday and Friday each week. The club also offers volunteering opportunities and supports people through their coaching certificates. The club will be holding a showcase in Holyhead Leisure Centre event in December.

Cybi Youth Shedz

Had £7,000 to buy equipment including a 3-D printer, cricut machine, laser burning machine and a power tool bundle. The equipment will be used by young people in the shed to develop their skills and confidence. It is hoped that the sessions support young people to foster meaningful connections in a safe space.



Cymell Cyf

Received £5,600 to expand on their current activities and to buy new equipment such as a lawnmower, polytunnel and digital printer. The organisation works with people with learning difficulties who make picnic tables, memorial benches and planters for the community.

Prosiect Addysg Bioamrywiaeth

Seiriol Alliance



Funded 10 community projects in 2024!

David Hughes Centre

Received £500. The Centre is creating a Community Equipment Store to loan event equipment such as lightweight staging, theatre accessories and gazebos to local charities and volunteer-run groups at very affordable rates.

Iorwerth Rowlands Centre

This busy centre is used by groups including the Scouts and the Over 50s Club. £1,734 was awarded to pay for the installation of energy saving lighting. The environment is one of the Alliance's priorities and this development will help reduce energy costs.

Llanfaes Play Area

£600 awarded to the volunteer-run play area on the Llanfaes Estate. The money will be used to complete the sensory garden designed for use particularly by children with neurodivergent conditions. The money will also purchase CCTV equipment to help prevent vandalism of the wider play area.

Llangoed Village Hall

£1,460.56 awarded to match-fund the purchase of a permanent wide cinema-standard screen to support the development of its busy programme of community film screenings for children, families and older people. Their ambitious plans will include Welsh language films.

Menai Straits Heritage Sailing

This local charity provides sailing-related activities for individuals with mental and physical health problems and its activities are an important part of the Alliance's social prescribing project. £750 has been awarded to provide equipment including a new foresail and safety items to support the charity's activities.



Plas Bodfa Projects CIC

Had £500 to provide a regular annual Sculpture Trail event in the Llangoed Aberlleiniog woodland area. This unique event will encourage local people of all ages to get out and enjoy the art and the outdoors. This grant will help ensure the event's sustainability long-term

The Puffin Community Newsletter

The quarterly Puffin newsletter includes all activities and events taking place and reaches readers who are unable to access the internet. £1000 awarded for future printing costs.



Green Prescribing Project

The Cwlwm Seiriol Project has now ended and £2500 has been awarded to ensure that the fortnightly green prescribing activities continue in partnership with the Cwlwm Seiriol Project. These activities have benefitted a large number of individuals with mental and physical health problems

Biodiversity Education Project

£955 provided to purchase equipment such as bird boxes and bug hotels and also support hedgerow planting in the three primary schools in the Seiriol area. This project is being undertaken in partnership with Local Nature Partnership Ynys Môn.

Comisiynydd Cenedlaethau'r Dyfodol
